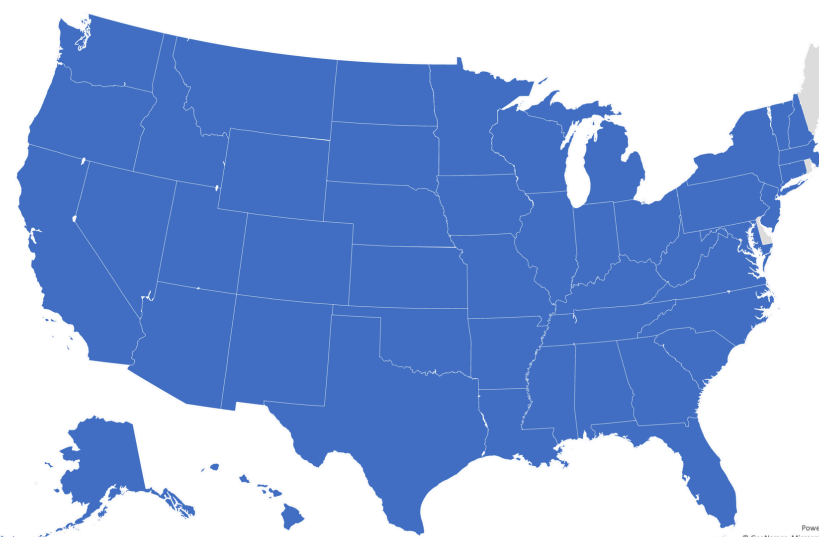




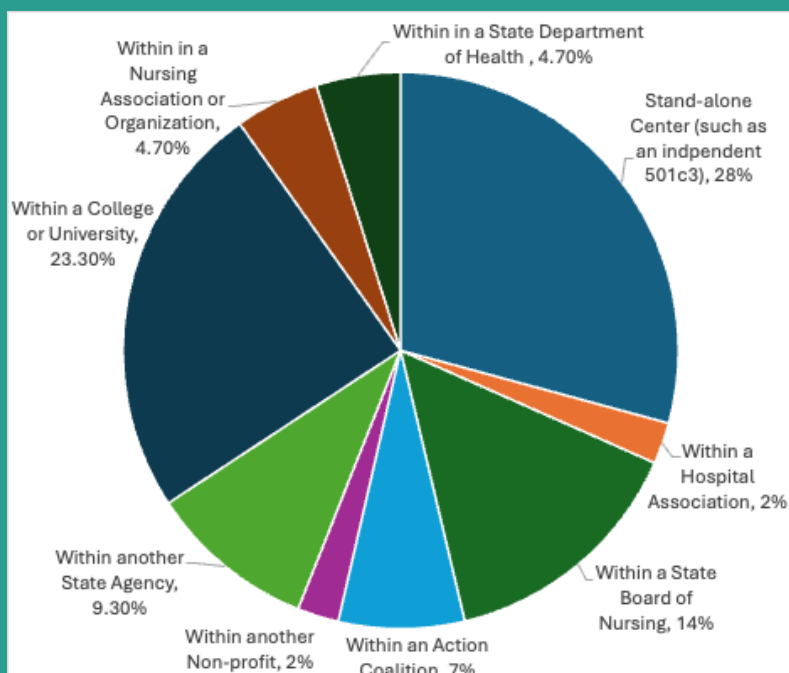
Subscribers
